# Arc de triomphe

Incredible views of the Champs-Élysées, the world's most beautiful avenue.

“ A project initiated by Napoleon I as early as 1806, the Arc de Triomphe is an iconic landmark in Paris, inaugurated in 1836 and dedicated to the armies of the Revolution and the Empire. The Unknown Soldier was buried beneath the monument in 1921, where the flame of remembrance is rekindled every day at 6.30 p.m. Inspired by the Roman Arch of Titus, the Arc de Triomphe is nonetheless unique in its remarkable dimensions and the absence of columns. Round off your private tour with breakfast atop the panoramic terrace while taking in the views of Paris.

## 2 | Sainte-Chapelle


A jewel of Gothic 'Rayonnant' architecture with more than 1,100 stained-glass windows.


“ A jewel of Gothic 'Rayonnant' architecture built in a record seven years and inaugurated in 1248, the Sainte-Chapelle became destined to house the most precious relics of Christianity including Christ's Crown of Thorns, acquired by Saint Louis. With these holy relics in his possession, the very powerful monarch was considered the Head of Western Christianity. Spread across 15 windows each measuring 15 metres in height, the stained-glass recounts the history of the world up until the arrival of the relics in Paris through 1,113 scenes from the Old and New Testament.


Come and discover this jewel of French heritage with a fascinating guided tour full of anecdotes from the History of France.

## 3 | Conciergerie

The medieval royal palace, where Marie-Antoinette was tried and imprisoned during the Revolution.

“ Of the medieval Palais de la Cité, only the Salle des Gardes (Hall of the Guards) and the immense Salle des Gens d’Armes (Hall of the Men-at-Arms) remain, built under Philippe le Bel, along with the kitchens constructed under Jean le Bon. The palace was abandoned by the Kings of France at the end of the 14<sup>th</sup> century, by which point they had moved to the Louvre and Vincennes. Judicial matters were referred here, and a prison was built. The Conciergerie became one of the major detention centres during the French Revolution with the establishment of the revolutionary court. Its most famous prisoner remains Marie-Antoinette.

Organise a cocktail reception or dinner or enjoy breakfast in one of the rooms within the Palace that was once home to the Kings of France. A private tour will plunge you deep inside the story behind this unmissable piece of French political history.

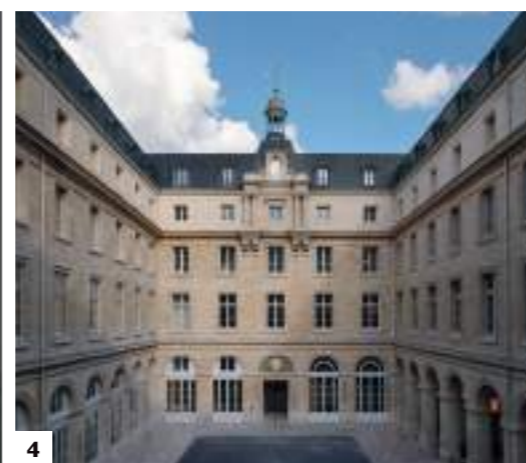
# 4 | Hôtel de la Marine

An iconic French heritage site with a breathtaking view over Place de la Concorde.

“ An iconic monument on Place de la Concorde, the Hôtel de la Marine is a magnificent architectural ensemble built in the 18<sup>th</sup> century by Ange-Jacques Gabriel, the king’s chief architect. Until 1798, it housed the Garde-Meuble de la Couronne, before becoming the headquarters of France’s navy ministry for over 200 years. Discover this unique monument in the heart of Paris with its refurbished apartments, its stately reception rooms and its restaurants in an entirely restored building. From the loggia, you can admire the hustle and bustle of one of the most historically rich places in Paris.

## 5 | July Column

A monument commemorating the citizens' defence of public liberties.

“ Built by order of Louis-Philippe and erected as a tribute to the victims of the revolution of the ‘Trois Glorieuses’, the Three Glorious Days or the July Revolution of 1830, and their fight, the triumphant column is topped by the ‘Spirit of Freedom’. Built on the site of the Bastille prison, the July Column was inaugurated in 1840. After the 1848 Revolution, Louis-Philippe’s throne was burned at the foot of the column, and the remains of the rioters were interred in the second vault of the monument. Following the fall of Napoleon III in 1871, during the Paris Commune, the monument narrowly escaped destruction.

The summit of the July Column affords a view like no other in Paris, and provides an exceptional setting for a marriage proposal.

## 6 | Panthéon

The Panthéon, a masterpiece by the architect Soufflot, stands upon mount Sainte-Genevieve.

“ Soufflot’s ambition was to build a monument to rival Saint-Peter’s in Rome or Saint-Paul’s in London. The monumental peristyle was inspired by Agrippa’s Pantheon in Rome. From 1874, paintings on marouflaged canvases illustrated the story of Sainte Genevieve and the epic story of France’s Christian and monarchic origins adorned the sanctuary. Since 2020, works by Anselm Kiefer and Pascal Dusapin have been added. The great historical figures buried in the crypt paint a picture of France’s national identity. A permanent exhibit tells of the life and accomplishments of those who rest there, from Voltaire and Rousseau to Josephine Baker.

Experience a tour of this place of collective memory from a whole new perspective and enjoy a cocktail beneath the columns while taking in panoramic views of Paris’ most iconic monuments such as the Eiffel Tower, Notre-Dame Cathedral, the Arc de Triomphe and Montmartre.

# Palais-Royal National Estate

In the heart of Paris, opposite the Louvre, discover a “city within a city”.

“ In 1624, Armand du Plessis, better known as the Cardinal Richelieu, was named Louis XIII’s Chief Minister. In order to be close to the King, who lived in the Louvre, he acquired the Hôtel de Rambouillet as his lodgings, which no longer exist today. He undertook major renovation works to create a sumptuous residence worthy of his rank. When he died, he left the residence to King Louis XIII of France, and it would belong to the royal family up until the Revolution of 1848. Ransacked and looted, it became the property of the French State and has housed the Council of State since 1875. Today, you can enjoy a stroll in the garden, a spot of lunch, or even a game of pétanque.

An exceptional setting for your corporate events, the gardens of the Palais-Royal are particularly in demand as the stage for fashion shows.

# 9 | Castle of Maisons

An architectural masterpiece of the Grand Siècle, set between Paris and Versailles.

“ Built by the architect François Mansart, the Château de Maisons, in Maisons-Laffitte, hosted a sumptuous celebration in 1651 attended by the young Louis XIV. The Sun King would later commission sculptors and decorators who had worked at Maisons to work on his palace of Versailles, along with the architect's great-nephew: Jules Hardouin Mansart. Considered to be one of the most beautiful homes of its time, the estate became the property of the Count of Artois in 1777, brother of Louis XVI and the future Charles X. It was acquired by Marshal Lannes in 1804. During the 19<sup>th</sup> century, the banker Jacques Laffitte subdivided its large grounds. The Château was saved from demolition by the French State in 1905.

Located on the outskirts of Paris and easily accessible by RER train, the Château de Maisons offers you the chance to organise your events within a true masterpiece of the 17<sup>th</sup> century.

# Saint-Cloud National Estate

460 hectares of gardens with vibrant fountains and sculptures just outside of Paris.

“ Built during the 16<sup>th</sup> century, the château and its grounds were embellished by Monsieur, the brother of Louis XIV, and his architects Le Pautre and Hardouin-Mansart. Queen Marie-Antoinette subsequently continued to transform the estate. A royal summer residence in the 19<sup>th</sup> century, the château fell victim to a fire in 1870. Due to its close ties to the monarchy and the Empire, the remaining parts of the building were demolished in 1892. Throughout the 18<sup>th</sup> century, sumptuous festivities were held at Saint-Cloud. Every September, the “fête de Saint-Cloud” attracts Parisians, merchants, showmen and entertainers.

Accessible via the Paris public transport system, the Domaine de Saint-Cloud, perched in its elevated position, affords panoramic views of Paris and the Eiffel Tower to impress your guests while adding a special touch to your events.

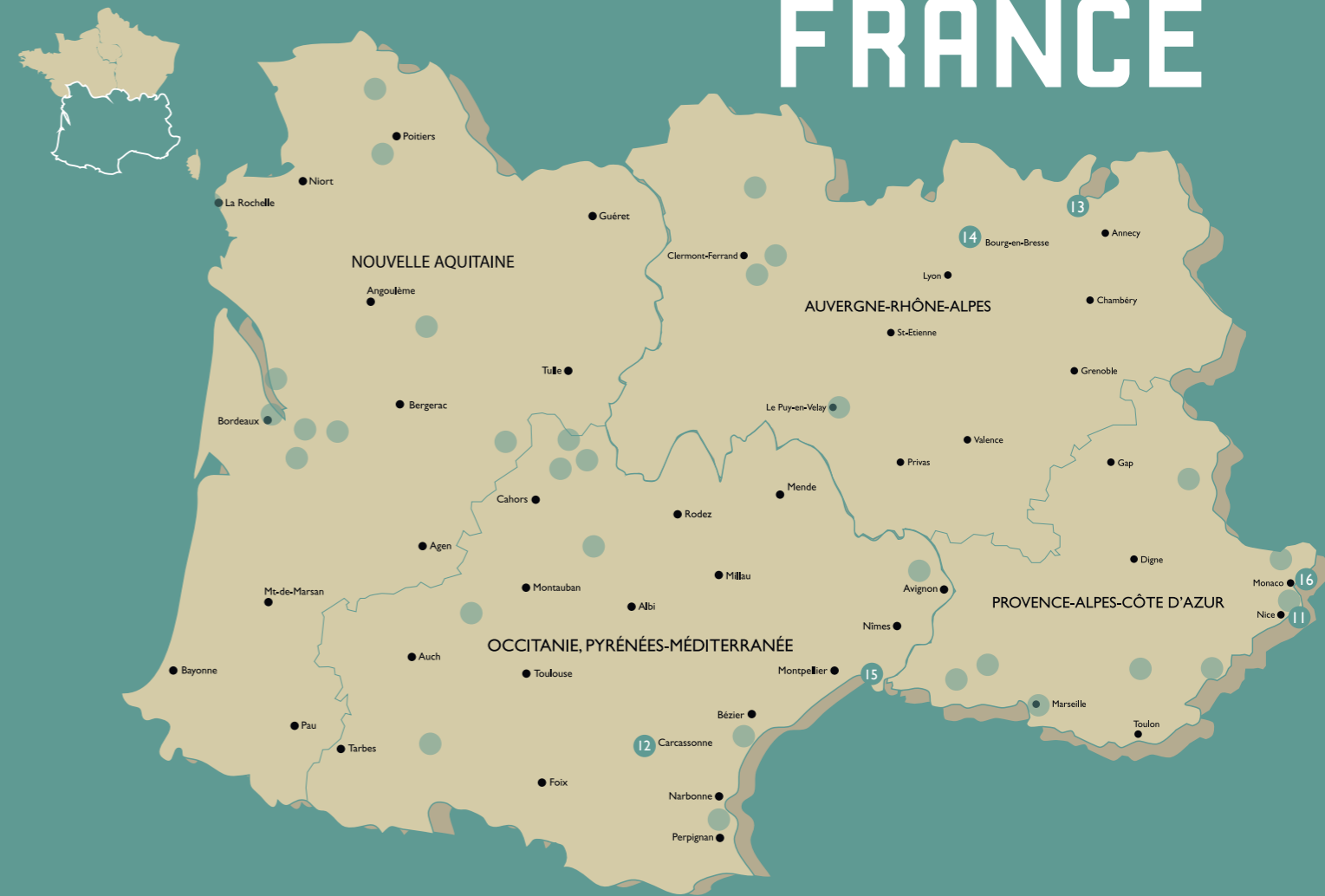

## Castle and Ramparts of the City of Carcassonne

The castle and its ramparts listed as a World Heritage Site.

“ The centre of power of the counts of Carcassonne and later of the famous Trencaville family during the 12<sup>th</sup> century, Carcassonne, accused of complicity with the Cathars, became a royal stronghold following the Albigensian Crusade (1209-1229), governed by a Seneschal. # 13 Castle of Voltaire in Ferney

The residence near the Swiss border where Voltaire spent the last 20 years of his life.

“ Located close to Geneva on the one hand, and the Haut-Jura regional nature park on the other, the castle of Voltaire is particularly well situated. It was built by its famous owner, Voltaire, where he spent the last years of his life finishing his philosophical and literary works. It is for this reason that the residence is listed as a historic monument. Following Voltaire's death, the castle and some of the furniture were sold and the Marquis de Villette, owner of the property between 1778 and 1785, dismembered the estate. The castle, the park, the orangery and the janitor's pavilion were finally bequeathed to the French State in 1999.

# 16 | Cap moderne – Villa E1027

A modern architectural ensemble from the mind of artist Eileen Gray.

“ A true icon of modern architecture, Villa E1027, Eileen Gray's first architectural creation, was built between 1926 and 1929, on ground overlooking the bay of Roquebrune-Cap-Martin, facing Monaco. # 19 | Cluny Abbey

# Villa Cavrois

## 21 | Palais du Tau

# Mont-Saint-Michel Abbey

Discover Mont-Saint-Michel and its abbey, one of the first sites inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List.

“ The cult of Saint Michael was introduced in 708 on the Mount, which became one of the largest medieval pilgrimage centres. The Benedictines later built an abbey there in the 10<sup>th</sup> century. During the Hundred Years' War, the heroic resistance of the Mount against the English earned it the status of a symbol of French identity. Abandoned by the monks in 1790, the abbey was listed as a historic monument in 1874. The entire site has since rekindled its past glory thanks to constant restoration work.

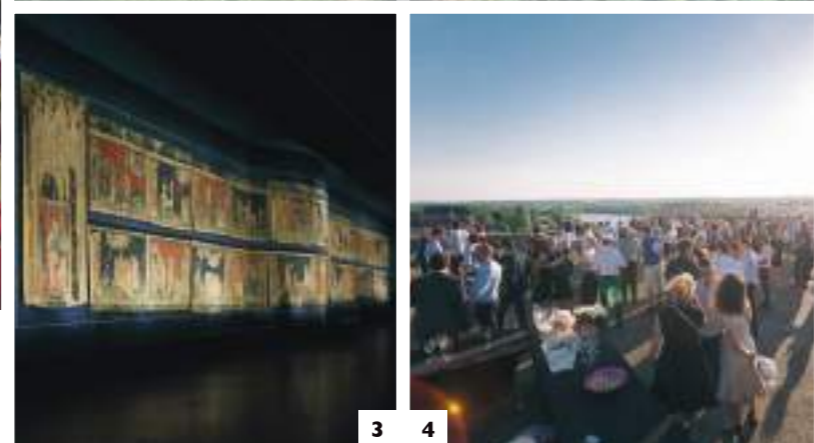

# Castle of Bouges

“ With records dating back to the 10<sup>th</sup> century, Bouges is a rural seigneurie with a fortified castle. The property has changed hands from owner to owner over the years, including the Medici family from 1416. The successive owners continued to multiply in the 19<sup>th</sup> century, the most notable among them being the Prince de Talleyrand, who acquired the château in 1818 for his niece by marriage, the Duchess of Dino, and owned it until 1826. In 1917, the château was sold to Henry Viguière, the owner of the Parisian department store BHV, and his wife Renée, who came from a rich family of drapers. In 1967, having no descendants, the couple left the estate and its collection to the Caisse Nationale des Monuments Historiques et des Sites, now the Centre des monuments nationaux.

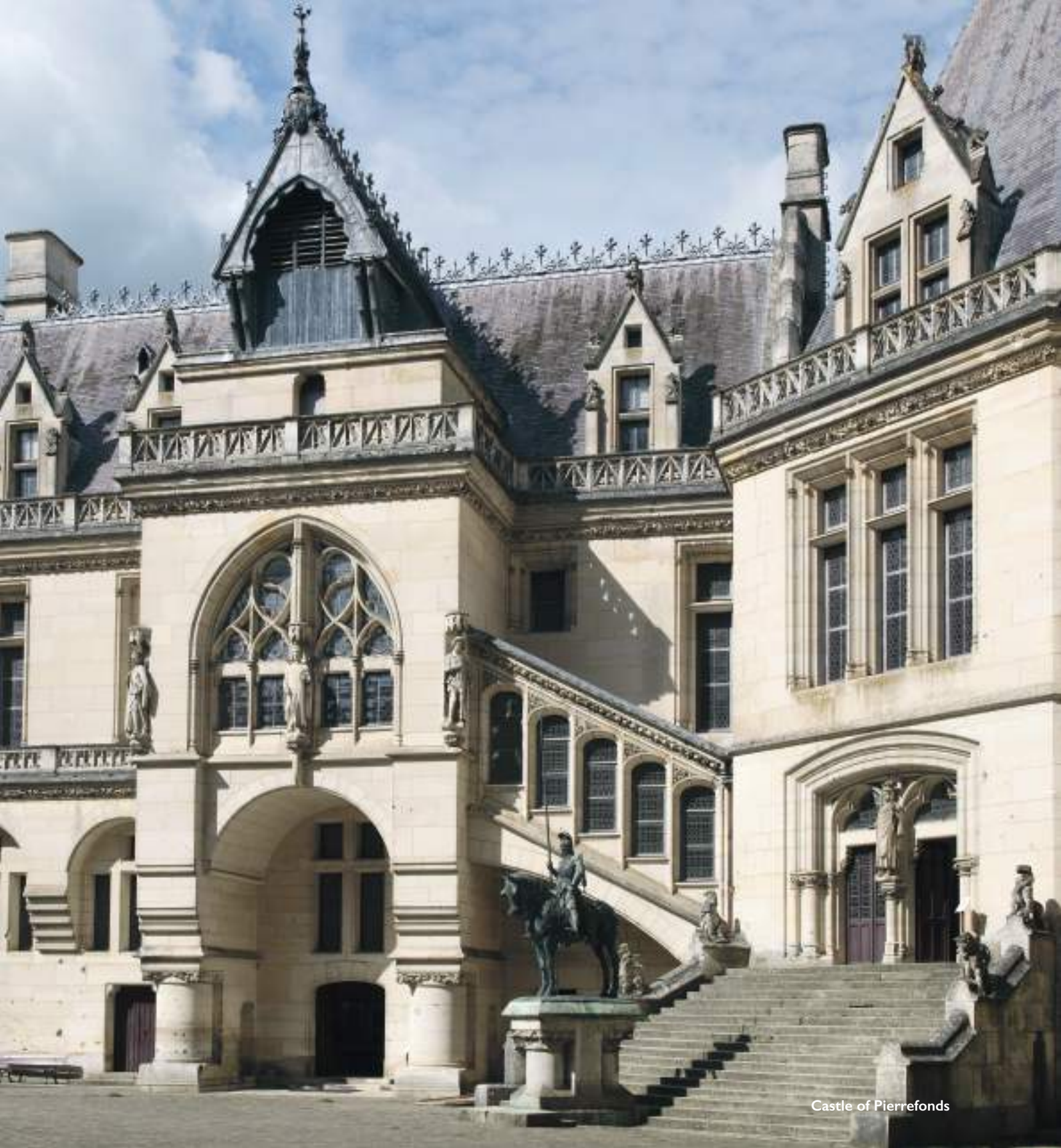
